


Director's Report to the Library Board of Trustees

- We have a license for Wandoo which is an online Summer Reading Club site that is customized for our library. We will have links to the dedicated website on our catalog page and on our website.
- We signed up for Stamps.com so that we can mail out materials for Summer Reading Club this year. For people who are offline, they can call and we will register them and mail them a packet. We are also doing craft kits for children and adults that we will mail.
 People will be able to sign up and we will have 20 kits per craft. Sarah, Hilary, Clare, and I will be doing a combination of live Zoom tutorials as well as recorded craft tutorials.
